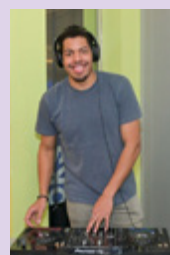
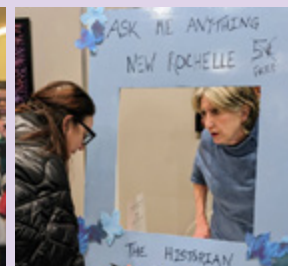

Foundation Announces \$666,000 Bequest by Dr. Ed Pasciuti

Gift will support programs for children and teens

On Sunday, December 11th members of the New Rochelle Public Library Board of Trustees and NRPL Foundation gathered to recognize Dr. Ed Pasciuti's generous gift of more than \$666,000 to support services and programs for children and teens at the library's main branch as well as the Huguenot Children's Library.

In recognition of this significant gift, NRPL Trustees Corey Galloway and Rhiannon Navin and NRPL Director, Tom Geoffino, announced that the Teen Center on the 2nd Floor of the Main Library will be renamed The Pasciuti Teen Center.

A product of the New Rochelle public school system, young Ed graduated from Princeton and then, as he recalled, faced an important choice. Although he had job offers that were more financially rewarding, he told his parents what he really wanted was to become a teacher – and so he did. Dr. Pasciuti went on to spend the next 40 years as a much loved and respected teacher and guidance counselor in the New Rochelle schools system.

Tom Geoffino, the Director of the NRPL, said "The New Rochelle Public Library applauds Dr. Ed Pasciuti's life of purpose and meaning supporting the youth of New Rochelle in his career as an educator in the New Rochelle School District. We commend him for his generous gift that will continue to enhance the lives of New Rochelle children and young adults long into the future."

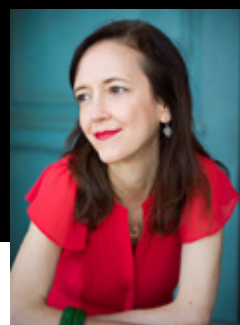
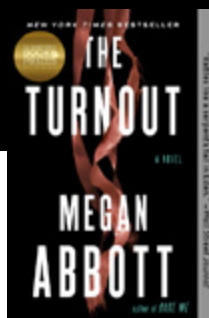
Cocktails & Conversation
